It should then pop up a link on the camera screen to 'mydona.com'. Click on that and it will open a Dona screen on your phone. You then have the choice of donating to Fr Paddy's Retirement or for Sunday Mass Offering. For teas and coffees etc you still need to use the machine in the narthex – we may add more options to the QR code later.
