Reverence in Church: Let this Easter season renew in us a sense of awe and wonder for the sacred nature of the Mass. Please can we try to keep an atmosphere of prayerfulness in the church and have any conversations after Mass in the narthex or hall, to allow those who wish to sit and pray the space to do so?

Foot washing at Maundy Thursday Mass: if you will be at this Mass (7pm, 17 April) and would be willing to have a foot washed, please add your name to the list on the notice-board in the narthex.

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. Fasting applies to those aged 18-60 unless pregnant, breastfeeding or not in full health. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Abstinence refers to the absence of meat or an alternate practice such as taking part in extra family prayer, going to Mass, or abstaining from e.g. alcohol or entertainment and applies to those over 14. However the Bishops of England and Wales encourage priests and parents to foster the spirit and practice of penance among those younger than this age limit.
