Message from Father Lee: I am delighted and a little daunted to be appointed Parish Priest of St Vincent's. Although I have been ordained for 12 years this is my first appointment as a parish priest. I have served in Sheffield for the last 8 years, as Catholic Chaplain to both universities and St Vincent's Mission Hub (SVMH) which was established in 2020. Such are the number of clergy in the diocese nowadays that Bishop Ralph has asked me to continue in all of these roles as well as becoming your parish priest. I am also the Vocations Director for the diocese. I already feel that I have your support and patience because it is going to take me some time to work out how to manage all of these ministries. In terms of Masses, I will celebrate weekday Masses at SVMH and our parish (and St Michael's once a month). When there isn't a weekday Mass here you are welcome to attend SVMH. In terms of Sunday Mass there is a clash with a 5pm Mass at SVMH and a 6pm Mass here. For now I am proposing that we move our 6pm mass to 6.30pm. We will then have a consultation across the parish and chaplaincy to work out the best times for our weekend Masses, hopefully having everything resolved by Advent. I am sorry for any inconvenience caused by this change. Please keep me in your prayers as I will you. God bless, Fr Lee Marshall.
