The congregation at the Mission Hub will be holding a party for Fr Lee that afternoon after 5 pm mass, so Fr Peter will be saying Mass at St Vincent's at 6.30 pm on Sunday 22 February.

The Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary is a great treasure of the Church and a wonderful Lenten devotion. St Louis de Monfort describes this consecration as "the surest, easiest, shortest, and most perfect means to becoming a saint." There are two versions: the original by St Louis de Monfort and a modern interpretation by Fr Michael Gaitley. Both will be shared on the parish WhatsApp. St Louis offers a short reflection followed by daily prayers, litanies and Rosary. Fr Gaitley offers a daily meditation on Our Lady through the spirituality of some modern great saints. Choose the one that suits you best. Beginning on 20 February, after 33 days of prayers you will be guided to place your life in the hands of Our Lady on the Annunciation (25th March) trusting that she will lead you to Jesus. If this programme feels too much, then a simple offering of your heart to Mary for 33 days will suffice. I hope you will join me in this powerful prayer this Lent. Fr Lee
