Mass on Monday 1st September (10.30am) at St. Michael's, Rivelin, This Mass is for the souls of all those buried at St. Michael's, and for our friends and relatives buried in Crookes cemetery. Father will be saying the prayers from the new Mass for the Care of Creation instituted by the Vatican and first offered by Pope Leo at Castel Gandolfo in July. Afterwards there will be an easy walk by the river along the Rivelin Valley to Hillsborough, with some prayer stops along the way. We can continue along the road to Sacred Heart church and say a final prayer there. A small Pilgrimage to mark the Jubilee and the Season of Creation. Save the date and let your friends in other parishes know.

Next Saturday, the 30th August, St Francis parishioners will be making a pilgrimage to Padley Chapel for the Jubilee Year. There are three walks for different levels of ability. The first (9 miles) sets off from St Francis at 10am. The second (2 miles) sets off from the cafe at Longshaw at 2pm, and the third (0.5 mile) from Grindleford Station car park at 3pm, At 4pm we will celebrate Mass in the Chapel.
