**Live Streaming of Masses:** Our parish is delighted to bring a new service to our parishioners. We have installed a new camera at the back of the church to allow us to share our services with those confined to their homes and to those who now live away from our parish. The camera is located at the back of the church facing the Sanctuary. It does not move or face the people in the congregation. Each day from Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> July we will stream our Mass and all other services to people using computers, phones and tablets all over the world where there is broadband available.

### **CAFOD Petition to address the Debt Crisis**

Many of the world's poorest countries have been plunged into a new debt crisis, and in this Jubilee Year, Pope Francis had called for urgent action to address it. The number of countries in debt crisis has more than doubled since 2015: 54 countries are now in debt crisis compared with 22 countries in 2015. Countries are having to make huge repayments on high-interest loans to banks, institutions, and governments. Often, countries have repaid their original debt several times over, but the debt will never be cleared because the interest on it keeps growing. Please sign the petition on the table in the narthex to demand action from governments around the world to address the debt crisis.
