

## Applying for a place at Sunday mass at St. Vincent's

As from Sunday 9 August there will be two Sunday Masses in St Vincent's church: 9.30am and 6pm.

The congregation will have to be reduced because of social-distancing (you may not be able to sit in your 'usual' seat).

Places are limited to those who have requested a place and have then received confirmation.

Initially this will be done by e-mail application only. We hope to add other means in the future but had to devise a simple system quickly to get started. We fully recognise this is not ideal (no system is), but it is how we are starting off. It will be reviewed, and will be enhanced and modified as we gain experience.

If you would like to come to Sunday Mass in the next few weeks but don't have access to e-mail, try and contact someone you know who does have access and apply with their help. Equally, if you know someone who would like to come to Sunday Mass but does not have access to e-mail please help them to apply for a place. Please give a contact name for 'track and trace' recording. Requests for more than one household must be on separate e-mails.

How to apply for a place at Sunday Mass

- Email [stvincentcrookesbooking@gmail.com](mailto:stvincentcrookesbooking@gmail.com) between Monday morning and Thursday by 6pm to request a place for the following Sunday.
- State clearly:
  1. **which Mass** (9.30am or 6pm);
  2. **how many places** you require;
  3. **a contact name.**Contact details will be kept for a maximum of 21 days.
- Please put the information in the subject line of the e-mail - eg. 9.30am 2 places Paddy Walsh
- You will hear by e-mail, by the end of Friday whether you have a place or not.
- If you are offered a place and find that you are no longer able to attend, please reply to the confirmation e-mail to let us know.
- If you are applying for more than one household please send separate e-mails

Note that mass from the parish will continue to be available online.
