Life issues

The baby's **heartbeat** is present from **22 days** after fertilisation; spontaneous movement begins from 6-7 weeks; **at 8 weeks the baby has fingers**, toes, a working digestive system and 90 per cent of his or her body parts have formed; at 10 weeks the baby's heart has already beat over 10 million times.
