#### **CAFOD** Fix the food system campaign

Thanks to all who have already signed Cafod's large letter of support for small-scale farmers. Last week's letter was completely filled, so there is a new one left in the narthex for new signatures.

The Season of Creation is an ecumenical celebration of God's gift of a home to us, starting on 1st. Sept. (World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation) and finishing on 4th October, (the feast of St. Francis of Assisi).

At St. Vincent's we now have a Prayer for Creation printed in the front of the hymn books which can be said during Mass.

During the season there will be a weekly Rosary for Creation said in church after the Wednesday morning Mass - about 10 O'clock - do join if you can.

Additionally, there will be a 'Sharing Table' of fruits of the earth after Sunday Mass. If you have a glut of fruit or veg from a garden or allotment, or an oversupply of plants or seeds, this is an opportunity to share them freely with others.
