Many thanks to all who supported the "Mystery Book" sale for St Justin Society on the 15th of October. £36 was raised which will be sent to one of the projects, in Africa, supported by the parish. We may have another sale next year. Watch this space!

Holy Day of Obligation: This Wednesday, 1st of November, is the Solemnity of All Saints. The Church requires us to go to Mass on this day, just like our Sunday obligation. Masses will be said across the diocese so you will have plenty of opportunity to go; we will have Mass at St. Vincent's at 7:00pm.

All Souls Day: Although All Souls may not be a Holy Day of Obligation it is a good time to go to Mass and pray for all the faithful departed. The theological basis for the feast is the doctrine that the souls which, on departing from the body are not perfectly cleansed from venial sins, or have not fully atoned for past transgressions, are not yet ready for the Beatific Vision, and that the faithful on earth can help them by prayers, almsgiving and especially the sacrifice of the Mass. Plenary Indulgence: From the 1st to the 8th of November inclusive, you can obtain a plenary indulgence, applicable only to the souls in Purgatory, by visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed. November Dead List: If you would like a Mass / Masses said for your loved ones throughout the year, you can pick up an envelope and information slip in the Narthex. Please return it in the sacristy or to the parish office.

This week's top tip for getting the most out of Holy Mass:

Join in the singing! There are many Bible verses that encourage us to sing to the Lord, making it clear that this is something God desires from us. In Matthew 26:30 we are told that even Jesus sang hymns. When we don't really want to sing, but do it anyway, it shows God that we are willing to put Him above all else. This is the most important reason that you should sing during the Mass. St. Augustine said that "He who sings prays twice." Our song is a praise offering to the Lord. The lyrics are more than just words, they are the prayer of the heart.
