Humanae Vitae – 50 years on. Pope Paul VI is to be canonised a saint this October. To a great extent the truth expounded in his encyclical, 'Humanae Vitae' will be 'canonised' as well. It was a prophetic divinely inspired document on Church teaching which should be upheld by everyone. Here is a short extract from it.

'Indeed it is to be feared that husbands who become accustomed to contraceptive practices will lose respect for their wives. They may come to disregard their wife's psychological and physical equilibrium and use their wives as instruments for serving their own desires. Consequently they will no longer view their wives as companions who should be treated with attentiveness and love.' (Paul VI)

6pm Sunday Mass: I'm considering introducing some Gregorian Chant singing into the 6pm Sunday Mass. I've already bought the necessary books. All we need is a small group of singers to get us started. Any volunteers. I already know how to sing the Mass using Gregorian chant from my pre-Vatican 11 days. We used to sing it as children. Gregorian chant is beautiful.

Moving the goalposts: The ruling by the Supreme Court last week permits doctors to withdraw food and water from someone in a vegetative or minimally conscious state – as long as the doctor and the patient's family agree that this is in the patient's "best interests". You can see from this that corners can easily be cut. St John Paul 11 back in 2004 called this "euthanasia by omission". Food and drink is not treatment but basic care.
