**Solly Street:** Work is due to begin on developing the New Chaplaincy centre, otherwise known as the 'Mission Hub', in September. The works encircling it are due to be completed by end of August. The work on the chaplaincy will take around six months. The aim is that everything will be up and running by the spring/summer of 2019.

**Parish clustering:** On 12th June there was a meeting held by Bishop Ralph and the Vicar General, Fr Des Sexton, to explain changes to the parishes of Sheffield in light of reducing numbers of priests serving the diocese. It is proposed that parishes are 'clustered' and Masses in the cluster be organised so that one priest can cover. St Vincent's has been clustered with Sacred Heart parish. The minutes of the meeting are in the narthex and another meeting is planned for 2nd October. Louise Finnigan and Pete Delamere attended as lay representatives of the parish. We look to holding a parish meeting to look at what this means to our parish. Date to be arranged.
