Mass at Padley: I have mass at Padley this Wednesday with Year 6 from St Marie's Primary School. As you know Padley is shrine of the Martyrs. During the mass I will say a few words about what happened there in the 16th century.

Next Sunday and extra Mass will be celebrated here at 12 noon with all the First Communion children six of whom will be making it for the first time. When the present crisis subsides parents should bring their children to Mass every Sunday. We lay emphasis on **FIRST** communion because it is meant to be the first of many throughout their lifetime. Confession is also important for children especially during Advent and Lent.
