That is the meaning of the word "Synodal" – it means "journeying together". This synodal process will be a two-year journey. We have sent out questionnaires – the more people we reach the better. Everyone's contribution is important and is valued. All questionnaires are confidential – they are in paper form or can be filled in on-line via the Parish website. Hopefully, early next year we will be able to gather in small groups to discuss our thoughts and pray together. Next March our views will be sent to Bishop Ralph and then passed on to Rome. There is more information on the parish and the Hallam Diocese website. **Ann Burke and Paul Jones** are the parish representatives for the synodal process. In the words of the Pope: "The purpose of the Synod is to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a new dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, and give strength to our hands."
