Thank you very much for your generous donation in the sum of £1000 to support our work in Kenya, Uganda and Ecuador. As you requested, I have split your donation between some of our programmes in the three countries.

Some of your donation will be given to Sister Anna Muindi to help with her work in the Turkana camp for displaced people in Marigat, in the Rift Valley region of Kenya. As well as other needs, there are a good number of elderly people in the camp who are neglected and Sister Anna gives them enough food each week to meet their basic needs.


Some money will also be given to help Sister Margaret Obwoye who works in Malindi, on the Kenya coast, with Community Based Health Care Workers who work with those who live in the slums and who are often HIV+ also and they assist them with advice and help with good nutrition and medicine.

Our Sisters in Uganda will receive your donation for their work among the Karimojong people where they live. It is a very remote and deprived area in the north of the country and so there are many needy people whom they help.

The remainder of the money will be given to Sr Frances who works in Quito, Ecuador. Sister Frances works with those who suffer from mental health problems and other related issues. As the majority of the people are from poor and very unstable family backgrounds Sister Frances would be unable to offer this service without financial assistance

We are very grateful for your generosity. Please be assured of a remembrance in our prayers and we ask you to keep us in your prayers.
