

## **THE UNION OF CATHOLIC MOTHERS**

"The Mothers" have met in St. Vincent's Parish since the early 1900's. They were first known as the Guild of St. Anne and met in the Parish hall on Monday afternoons before collecting their children from school. When the Chapel of Ease opened on School Road, Crookes, Sr. Agnes, a Daughter of Charity suggested that mothers from Crookes and Walkley (St Joseph's) should join the National organisation of the Union of catholic Mothers. This was in 1958 and the group has met on a very regular basis ever since. The number of members has dropped since those early days but 14 members still meet on a Wednesday evening after the evening Mass. New members would be very welcome.
